Administrator's Guide

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Overview

Use the application to manage energy consumption, noise, toner usage, and paper usage settings to help reduce the environmental impact of the printer.

Configuring the application

Configuring energy- and paper-saving options

- 1 From the Embedded Web Server, access the configuration page for the application.
- 2 Adjust the energy- and paper-saving settings.

Notes:

- Some printer models let you print on both sides of the paper.
- Selecting **Energy/Paper** automatically sets **2-Sided Printing** and **Sleep Mode** to the default values.
- Quiet Mode may reduce the processing speed, delaying the time before the first page is printed.
- Lock UI prevents users from changing the settings from the control panel.
- The settings may vary depending on the printer model.
- For more information on each setting, see the mouse-over help.

- 3 Apply the changes.

Scheduling energy-saving tasks

- 1 From the Embedded Web Server, access the configuration page for the application.
- 2 Add or edit a scheduled power mode.
- 3 Select an energy-saving task, and then set the time and day for the printer to perform the task.
- 4 Apply the changes.

Configuring the settings from the control panel

Note: Make sure that **Lock UI** is not selected in the configuration page for the application.

- 1 From the home screen, touch the application icon.
- 2 Adjust the settings.
- 3 Apply the changes.

Enabling Eco-Mode

- 1 Touch **Eco-Mode**, and then select a setting.

Notes:

- Some printer models let you print on both sides of the paper.
- Selecting **Energy/Paper** automatically sets **2-Sided Printing** and **Sleep Mode** to the default values.

- 2 Apply the changes.

Enabling two-sided printing

- 1 Touch **2-Sided Printing**.
- 2 Select **2-Sided Long Edge** or **2-Sided Short Edge**.
- 3 Apply the changes.

Enabling Quiet Mode

- 1 Touch **Quiet Mode > On**.
- 2 Apply the changes.

Note: Quiet Mode may reduce the processing speed, delaying the time before the first page is printed.

Setting other options

- **Standby Mode**—Set how long the printer goes into standby mode.
- **Sleep Mode** or **Power Saver**—Set how long the printer goes into Sleep Mode or Power Saver mode.
- **Screen Brightness**—Set the brightness of the screen.
- **Toner Darkness** or **Darkness**—Set the darkness of the printed documents.

Scheduling energy-saving tasks

- 1 Touch  or **Advanced Options**.
- 2 Select an energy-saving task, and then set the time and day for the printer to perform the task.
- 3 Touch  or **Add**.
- 4 Apply the changes.

Note: Changes made to tasks from the control panel are also applied in the Embedded Web Server.

Appendix

Accessing the configuration page for the application using the Embedded Web Server

- 1 Open a Web browser, and then type the printer IP address.

Note: View the IP address in the TCP/IP section of the Network/Ports menu.

- 2 Click **Settings** or **Configuration**.
- 3 Depending on your printer model, do one of the following:
 - Click **Apps > Apps Management**.
 - Click **Device Solutions > Solutions (eSF)**.
 - Click **Embedded Solutions**.
- 4 Select the application from the list, and then click **Configure**.

Customizing the application icon

- 1 From the Embedded Web Server, access the configuration page for the application.
- 2 Specify the text and image that you want to appear on your home screen.

Note: Some applications require changing the settings from the profile page.
- 3 Apply the changes.

Exporting or importing a configuration file using the Embedded Web Server

- 1 From the Embedded Web Server, access the configuration page for the application.
- 2 Export or import the configuration file.

Notes:

- If a **JVM Out of Memory** error occurs, then repeat the export process until the configuration file is saved.
- If a timeout occurs and a blank screen appears, then refresh the Web browser, and then click **Apply**.

Checking the version of the Embedded Solutions Framework

- 1 From the Embedded Web Server, click **Reports > Device Settings**.
- 2 In the Embedded Solutions section, note the value associated with "Framework =."
